





#### Summary and discussion

#### Treatment satisfaction

- → Clinicians markedly more positive than patients, and this difference increases as clinicians get older
- → Greek patients more positive than those from other countries

#### Diagnostics and treatment

- → Diagnostics and treatment more diverse in Germany, but also less time per patient
- → Treatment diversity had no effect on patient satisfaction, but resulted in higher satisfaction of clinicians

#### Educational needs

- → Across countries, both patients and clinicians most interested in learning more about treatment strategies
- → Especially among patients, interest in a wide range of topics
